WHAT TO KNOW

Before you can be accepted into our Apprenticeship Program, you must meet these requirements:

- You must be 18 years of age
- You must have a Valid Government Issued Photo ID and Social Security Number
- You must be physically fit to work in this industry and pass our entry assessment, also known as "Bootcamp."
- Bootcamp is a 3-day process
 - Day 1: Drug Test and Enrollment Paperwork
 - Day 2: Physical Agility Test
 - Day 3: Physical Agility Test and Oral Interview



HOW TO APPLY

- Call our office and request an application, apply online at www.BricktenderJAC.com, under the 'Apprenticeship' tab or scan the QR code with your phone!
- Wait to be invited to a boot camp or find a signatory employer that can sponsor you to bypass the waiting process.
