WHAT TO KNOW

Before you can be accepted into our Apprenticeship Program, you must meet these requirements:

- You must be 18 years of age
- You must have a Valid Government Issued Photo ID and Social Security Number
- You must be physically fit to work in this industry and pass our entry assessment, also known as "Bootcamp."
- Bootcamp is a 3-day process

Day 1: Drug Test and Enrollment Paperwork

Day 2: Physical Agility Test

Day 3: Physical Agility Test and Oral Interview

Call our office and request an application, apply online at www.BricktenderJAC.com, under the 'Apprenticeship' tab or scan the QR code with your phone!

Wait to be invited to a boot camp or find a signatory employer that can sponsor you to bypass the waiting process.
